

## Guidelines for Contributors

### These guidelines apply to all scientific (peer-reviewed) articles submitted to eco.mont

*The manuscript must not exceed 30 000 characters (including spaces, title, abstract, keywords, references)*

Contributions should follow a systemic, integrative, synthetic or networking approach with reference to a specific research question.

**The abstract** explains the major contributions of the article to the general reader.

**The introduction** briefly and concisely presents the research question, scientific background and state-of-the-art for the subject matter of the article, with reference to the literature, and should embed the contribution in the scientific context.

**The methods section** presents the methods used in the research for the article. Standard methods need not be described in detail. Special methods to be presented in a short summary.

Results and discussion should be treated separately.

**Results** are described and also presented in tables and figures which must be referred to in the text.

In the **discussion** the results are evaluated and, if possible, compared to other and differing results and interpretations from other studies by other authors, again with reference to the sources in the literature.

The **conclusion** must correspond to the hypotheses and questions formulated at the beginning and may include an outline of recommendations, future perspectives as well as open questions.

- ▶ Articles must not have been previously published (including on the internet).
- ▶ The articles submitted are expected to be written in clear English.
- ▶ The editors reserve the right to edit the English text. Extensive alterations will be discussed with the authors.
- ▶ Please upload your article via the Open Journal System.

  - **Please do not use footnotes in the manuscript.**
  - Please number all **pages and lines**
  - **First page:**
    - » title of article
    - » authors' names – unless otherwise requested, only the first-named author will be the main correspondent for the editors -
    - » affiliations
    - » keywords
    - » full addresses, including email addresses
    - » short biographies, max. 40 words, of all authors

    - » *Authors must ensure that written permission has been granted to publish or reproduce already copyrighted photographs, illustrations, tables, quotations or other material that can be reproduced only with written permission from the copyright owners.*
  - **All tables, figures, pictures must be referred to in the text in numerical order.**
- ▶ The metric system should be used for all measurements, and numerical units should conform as closely as possible to the International System of Units (SI).

- ▶ Please provide place names spelled in the form officially used in the country under discussion and in English.
- ▶ Please provide latitude and longitude coordinates for the regions referred to in the article.
- ▶ All authors to eco.mont are fully responsible for the content and opinions expressed in their writings.
- ▶ References should be listed at the end of the paper in alphabetical order by the author, following the eco.mont guidelines for references, see [references.pdf](#)
- ▶ All references should be carefully cross-checked
