

Ensuring a Blind Review

To ensure the integrity of the blind peer-review for submission to eco.mont, every effort should be made to prevent the identities of the authors and reviewers from being known to each other. This involves the authors, editors, and reviewers (who upload documents as part of their review) checking to see if the following steps have been taken with regard to the text and the file properties:

- ▶ Please remove author identification from documents.
- ▶ Cite papers published by the Author in the text as follows: (Author, 2020).
- ▶ For anonymizing in the reference list use Author(s). Details omitted for peer review.
- ▶ Footnotes only if necessary and remove any identifying information.
- ▶ Make sure figures and tables, including figure and table labels and captions don't contain any affiliation related identifiers.
- ▶ Remove references to funding sources and do not include acknowledgments.
